Tour De Lion Ride Information Cont'd...

STEP 2: COLLECT SPONSORS AND SUPPORTERS. Use attached sheets or just add on extra sheets of paper. All sponsorship money listed on forms is due in full and will be collected upon registration prior to each ride.

STEP 3: WEAR YELLOW: Come in yellow, dress up, wear dandelions, or other fun yellow accessories, get funky and get into the spirit of Spring by choice of course!

STEP 3: REGISTER FOR YOUR RIDE ON RIDE DAY: ALL riders MUST register! Please arrive at your ride's beginning station at least 30 minutes before your start time. Have all your collected donations, sponsor forms and parental signatures or parent (when necessary) with you. All riders under 18 must have helmets and locks with you or you will not be allowed to ride. Make sure we know your T-Shirt size!

STEP 4: RIDE SAFELY AND WITH RESPECT AND COURTESY FOR OTHER RIDERS: We want you to have fun but any riders disobeying Dandelion Day Officials, emergency and medical personnel on-site will be asked to leave.

STEP 5: STAY ON YOUR ROUTE AND SIGN IN AT END: All Riders must stay on the routes laid out for each ride and go directly to the welcoming tent at Millennium Park to register completion of their ride. You will then be given a complimentary ticket for our Grand Prize Draw of the day! You will also be notified if you are eligible for any other prizes.

STEP 6: ENJOY THE MUSIC, FUN & FOOD AT DANDELION DAY FESTIVAL: We will provide a safe bicycle storage area at the end of the race so you can enjoy the rest of the festival. Prize winners will be announced from the Sun Stage at 2:00pm. Be ready to have your picture taken with the Big Dandee!

Tour de Lion 2017 Sunday May 28, 2017 Rules & Waiver Agreement

Please read and fill out in full:

Rules: Tour de Lion(TdL) is a Transition Town Peterborough Inc. event held concurrently with Dandelion Day Festival(DDF) at Millennium Park, Peterborough.

- 1) Each entry must have the minimum amount required in pledge per person as listed for each ride entered in. Use attached form to record pledges and use additional sheets if necessary.
- 2) All proceeds raised by riders in pledges will be donated to the United Way Peterborough. All pledge monies will be collected and given to Dandelion Day Festival officials upon registration at the event prior to starting ride at each location.
- 3) **All riders are required to provide and use their own helmets and bike locks.** DDF will provide a secure corral area to park and store bikes at the end of the TdL rides at Millennium Park. Yellow costumes and themed accessories are highly recommended and welcome.
- 4) Riders will not consume alcohol or drugs on the day of the event prior to riding. Any rider suspected of disobeying this rule will be excluded from participating in the ride. All pledge monies raised will still be dispersed as noted in Rule 2.
- 5) Riders will be in good health to participate. Please consult a Doctor if in doubt. **All riders** will carefully read and sign the liability waiver below in order to participate - NO EXCEPTIONS
- 6) All Riders must stay on the routes laid out for each ride and go directly to the welcoming tent at Millennium Park to register completion of their ride. Riders will obey instructions of Dandelion Day Officials, emergency and medical personnel on-site.
- 7) Riders must register no later than ½ hour prior to their ride start. (See Attached) Each ride has designated parking areas, drop off zones and registration tents. All riders MUST register prior to starting ride at the appropriate location.
- 8) Riders are responsible to bring their own towels, water bottles, etc. to the event. Any personal property left at the site after the event will be disposed of.
- 9) Minimum Age Requirements:
 - i) Wild Rock Avid Cyclists (55km) – 14 years old. 14- 16 year olds MUST be accompanied by an adult.
 - ii) PCNM Trent Trail Family Ride (10km) - all riders under 16 MUST be signed in by an adult.
 - iii) Camp Ponacka All Wheels Mini Ride (1km) - all riders under 13 must be signed in by parent /guardian.
